# Draft interactive state water plan website

- The draft interactive state water plan (iSWP) website based on the draft 2026 Regional Water Plan data is now available. Use the interactive site to explore regional water plan data in geographical and tabular forms. Please note that until TWDB staff finish a review of the data, there may be issues with how the application functions. Staff will be correcting data issues and updating the iSWP periodically until the regional water plans are approved.

# Program Activities

Regional water planning area boundary review:

- The TWDB is currently reviewing the designated regional water planning areas to determine whether any updates to the boundaries are necessary. Members of the public were encouraged to submit relevant comments concerning the existing regional water planning area boundaries to [RegionalWaterPlanning@twdb.texas.gov](mailto:RegionalWaterPlanning@twdb.texas.gov) by Monday, June 30, at 5:00 p.m. The TWDB may consider proposing boundary revisions at a regular Board meeting.

# Program Activities

Socioeconomic impact analysis reports for regional water plans:

- The TWDB provided a report to each region that estimates the annual socioeconomic impacts of not meeting identified water needs for each water use category and as an aggregate for the region. Following release of the reports, more information will be available on the TWDB Socioeconomic Impact Analysis webpage, including a dashboard that summarizes the data in the report, the methodology for the analysis, and frequently asked questions.
